Peaks that are around 4500 feet elevation.

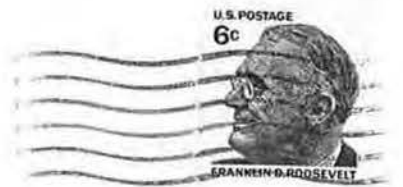
